Class 201 A coloured photo that shows your garden's composition

the structures, tones, textures and colours of its plants. The part of the garden shown should be 5 metres frontage or less. The photo should be 8 x 6 inches or 20 x 15 cms in size and printed onto an A4 size piece of paper. You can give your garden a name ('My Peaceful Place' or 'The Jungle', for example.) The name should be written on the A4 piece of paper and must not identify you.

Class 203 Stock, three distinct, no laterals

Class 204 Sweet peas, six distinct

Class 205 Geranium, one double

Class 206 Geranium, one single

Class 207 Geranium, ivy

Class 208 Flowering climber/creeper, one distinct, one cut

Class 209 Iris, one cut

Class 210 Daffodil, one cut

Class 211 Orchid, one cut

Class 212 Bulb, one flowering

Class 213 Native floral bloom, one cut

Class 214 Flower, not otherwise mentioned

Class 215 Flowering shrub, one cut with foliage, can be a native

Class 216 Flowering shrubs, cut, three distinct, can be native in individual jars (can be the same species)

- VASE: Container to be taller than its width
- BOWL: Container to be less than its width
- POT: Container to be round or square
- Arrangements in classes 217-229 should be displayed in a vase, bowl or pot

Class 217 Arrangement of Perennials

Class 218 Arrangement of Nasturtiums, own foliage

Class 219 Arrangement of Sweet Peas

Class 220 Arrangement of five flowers of the same variety with own or other foliage

Class 221 Arrangement of five flowers of different varieties with own or other foliage

Class 222 Arrangement of cut foliage, includes native foliage

Class 223 Arranged trough of assorted or same flowers, facing one way, includes native flowers

Class 224 Arrangement of flowers of one colour, may be more than one shade of that colour

Class 225 Arrangement of cereal crop, may be more than one variety

Class 226 Arrangement representing song title, named

Class 227 Dried Arrangement - a small arrangement of dried and/or preserved flowers and foliage suitable for an event

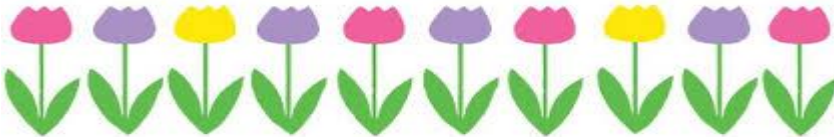
Class 228 Dried Arrangement - a large arrangement of dried and/or preserved flowers and foliage suitable for an event

- POTS/CONTAINERS: any shape, no more than about 32cms in diameter at the top.
- Terrarium: Must be able to be carried by one person.
- They must be clean with no labels visible.
- Pot plants must have been grown in pots for not less than two months and belong to exhibitor

Class 230 Pot Plant in bloom, not bulb or orchid, one plant only

Class 231 Pot Plant in bloom, bulb, bulbs or orchid

Class 232 Pot Plant of ferns or foliage, any kind

Class 233 Pot of Cacti

Class 234 Pot of Succulents

Class 235 Pot of Flowering Succulents

Class 236 Geranium, single

Class 237 Geranium, double

Class 238 Indoor pot plant

Class 239 Plant in Novel Container

Class 240 Miniature Garden

Class 241 Cacti/Succulents, group of three containers

no larger than 10cms across at top

Class 242 Hanging basket or container, in flower

Class 243 Hanging basket or container, for foliage
